Faris Dževahirić is rapidly becoming one of the most talked-about young forwards in the Region. At just 18 years of age, the towering **1.92m left footed** striker has already carved out a name for himself as a generational talent, with a blistering top speed of **35 km/h** and an uncanny ability to find the back of the net.

Dževahirić first came into the spotlight during the 2022/23 season, where he delivered a record-breaking campaign for FK Borac in the Bosnian U15 Premier League. In a feat that left scouts and statisticians stunned, Faris netted over **70 goals** - an astronomical figure considering the league's second-best scorer managed just 19. His physical dominance, pace, and footballing intelligence made him virtually unplayable at that level.

Despite attracting interest from some of Europe's most prominent clubs, Faris and his family made the move to Slovenia for work-related reasons. This transition saw him join **NK Domžale's U17 side**, a club that had just transferred their previous striking prodigy, **Benjamin Šeško**, **to FC Salzburg**. The expectation was immediate - and immense.

However, Faris's journey hit an unexpected roadblock due to FIFA regulations regarding the international transfer of minors, especially between non-EU and EU federations. Though the move was based on family relocation and not footballing intent, **Dževahirić was sidelined from official competition for over six months**. During that time, he remained ineligible to register with Domžale, forced to sharpen his game through friendlies only.

Even limited to exhibition matches, Faris showcased his **elite potential—scoring hat-tricks** against the likes of **NK Dinamo Zagreb**, **NK Lokomotiva Zagreb**, and even **Qatar's U20 national team**. His performances were a statement: the long wait had only made him hungrier.

Once clearance finally came, Faris immediately jumped into **Domžale's U19 setup** at age 16, skipping ahead of his age group, as well as training with NK Domžale first team. Not long after, he earned a move to **FC Celje**, where he announced himself with perhaps the most jaw-dropping individual performance in Slovenian youth football history. **In just 45 minutes**, he scored **5 goals**, provided **2 assists**, and **earned a penalty**—a record-setting display that reverberated across the region.

Now firmly on the radar of European clubs, **Faris Dževahirić** stands as one of the brightest striker prospects in the Balkans at this moment.



BIH YOUTH NATIONAL TEAM

Faris Dževahirić made a strong impression on the international stage with the Bosnia and Herzegovina U15 national team, debuting on July 9, 2021, under the guidance of coach Igor Janković at the age of 14. During his time with the squad, he earned five caps and scored four goals in international friendly matches, amassing a total of 254 minutes of play. His performances at the youth level demonstrated his striking potential and technical proficiency, marking him as one of the most promising forwards of his generation.

Despite his early success with the national team, Faris has not received a another call-up, largely due to organizational challenges within the Bosnian Football Federation. However, he remains open and willing to represent Bosnia and Herzegovina again in the future, should he be considered for selection. At the same time, the possibility of representing another country at the international level has not been ruled out. Faris has already received offers of citizenship from several countries in both Europe and the Middle East, expressing interest in him joining their respective national teams.

PLAYING STYLE & ATTRIBUTES

Faris Dževahirić is a **high-octane**, **vertical striker** who plays with relentless energy and a fearless approach. His game is built around explosive movement, direct attacking runs, and a willingness to take risks—whether that means charging at defenders, shooting from difficult angles, or chasing down every lost ball.

He thrives in **transitional moments**—counter-attacks, broken plays, or defensive mistakes. Faris loves to exploit space behind the backline and drags defenders out of position with his aggressive, unpredictable movement. He's not the most refined striker, but that raw edge often works in his favour: defenders simply don't know what he's going to do next.

Physical

• Pace & Acceleration:

Lightning fast in straight lines; quickest over distance. This makes him lethal in open play and counter-attacks.

• Strength & Power:

Uses his body well to hold off defenders, battle in duels, and power through challenges. He plays with real physical aggression.

Stamina & Work Ethic:

Tireless presser. He chases defenders, hounds goalkeepers, and covers ground like a wide forward.

Aerial Ability:

He is able to score headers, but his aerial offence needs polishing, especially ball trajectory anticipation and head knock timing.

Technical

Finishing:

Has a perfect striker's instinct for being in the right place. Clinical inside the box, with a variety of footy finishes: powerful low shots, driven efforts, and composed one-on-ones. Comfortable using both feet, though much stronger with his left. Right foot finishes are only occasional. Can produce brilliant finishes-curlers, volleys, powerful drives—but also prone sometime to the wayward or rushed shot.

Dribbling:

Direct, forceful runner. He's not a finesse dribbler but he is hard to stop when he builds up speed. Loves taking on defenders in wide areas.

First Touch & Control:

Can be inconsistent. Sometimes controls and turns defenders beautifully, other times miscontrols. Still a developing area which is improving daily.

Link-Up Play:

Better in wide/open spaces than in tight central combinations. Willing to pass and make unselfish runs, but not at the level of "false 9" or deep-lying link man.

Off-the-Ball Movement:

One of his biggest strengths. Constantly searching for gaps, stretching defences, and running behind defenders. Reads space well and times his runs effectively.

Mental and Tactical Traits

Fearless & Aggressive:

Always looks to push forward. He doesn't shy away from contact or mistakes—he just keeps going.

Instinctive, Not Calculated:

Makes fast, aggressive decisions. This sometimes leads to chaotic moments, but also produces brilliance defenders can't prepare for.

Positional Awareness:

Excellent at **timing runs** into the box or drifting wide to create overloads. He reads the game well and adapts to defensive structures.

Pressing & Defensive Work:

A manager's dream—relentless presser who leads the first line of defense. His positioning and timing help break opposition build-ups.

Versatility:

Can play as a lone striker, in a two-man partnership, or drift wide to isolate defenders. Fits into various tactical setups.


Emotional & Passionate:

Wears his heart on his sleeve. That passion energises teammates and fans.

CONCLUSION

Faris Dževahirić is a raw, electrifying striker who thrives in chaos. He's not a polished technician, but he's a constant threat due to his pace, movement, power, and hunger for goals. Think of him as a force of nature—he might miss a sitter one minute and score a worldie the next. And that's exactly what makes him so thrilling to watch.

If you're building a team that wants to play vertical, aggressive, fast-paced football, Faris is the kind of striker who can tear defences apart on his day.
